Preventive Radiological/Nuclear Detection Team Leader

This course provides instrument operation skills needed by the first responders when responding to a radiological or nuclear incident. The course provides a general overview of detection equipment, its selection, and its general operation. The training will encompass basic operations of the following: dosimeters, Personal Radiation Detectors, (PRDs), Human Portable Radiation Detectors (Backpacks), survey meters, portal monitors, and Radio-Isotope Identifier Devices (RIIDs). The course will enable participants to select the appropriate instrument operation in performance of that mission.

Objectives

The Participant will be able to demonstrate the supervisory skills required for the Team Leader position, and proficiency in the performance of the duties associated with the position, as outlined in the NIMS typing documents. The Participant will show their knowledge of the Team Operator Position and will be provided the opportunity to apply this knowledge to real world scenarios and practical exercises. At the completion of the course the Participant will complete the qualification and credentialing process with his/her agency by use of a Position Task Book (PTB) supplied with the course materials.

Target Audience/Discipline

Law Enforcement Officers (LEO) and Public Safety personnel assigned the PRND mission and working at the Team Leader level. This could include federal, state, local, territorial, and tribal (F/SLTT) personnel.

Eligibility

Eligible course participants will fall within the target audience and are responsible to perform radiological detection operations.

- ICS-200 Basic Incident Command/ ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents
- IS-700 National Incident Management System (NIMS): An Introduction
- PRND Screener Type two (2) and one (1) as verified by the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ)
- PRND Team Operator training that meets the competencies and behaviors identified for the position of PRND Type one (1) Team Operator as verified by the AHJ
